## Educate Against Hate – Website

The Government has created an 'educate against hate' website as it ramps up its drive against extremism in schools.

The website warns parents and teachers about excessive time spent online or on mobile phones as well as being wary of children with a susceptibility to conspiracy theories and a feeling of persecution.

The website draws attention to warning signs that children may be at risk which may include showing a particular interest in what is happening overseas and also wanting to shut down debate or pursue the path of segregation, not something that we want to see in this country.

Of course children will spend time online, but the question is "What are they looking at?" That's a conversation for all of us, but as parents we also need to make sure we do know as much as we possibly can when it comes to what children are looking at.
