Your child is one of the few students selected to take part in this activity as we are only able to accommodate a limited number. This is an excellent opportunity for them to be involved in a responsible and positive out of school learning experience. There is no cost attached to this course for students.


These activity sessions are all part of the John Muir Award, a national qualification that will result in certification for the pupils on completion of the course. They will take place over six weeks, with each session lasting only two school periods. All sessions will take place at the Suffolk Wildlife Trust's Education Centre at Bradfield Woods.

All students will travel supervised to and from school to Bradfield Woods in the school mini bus. We will leave at 1.00pm and return in time for the start of period 6 or at the end of the school day at 3.30pm. Students will need to bring a packed lunch with them for the trip and if they usually have a free school meal then they will be able to pick this up from Lilies. They should also bring plenty of drink for rehydration during the activity.
