This means:	Provide course guides that set out expectations, dates, topic breakdowns, and how to succeed.
1. Read/research beyond essential resources and manage self-directed study effectively.	Provide qualitative individual feedback regularly (DIRT).
2. Engage with staff and activities in lessons.	Provide quantitative feedback in the form of Go4Schools Markbook regularly.
3. Meet published deadlines (see course guides).
